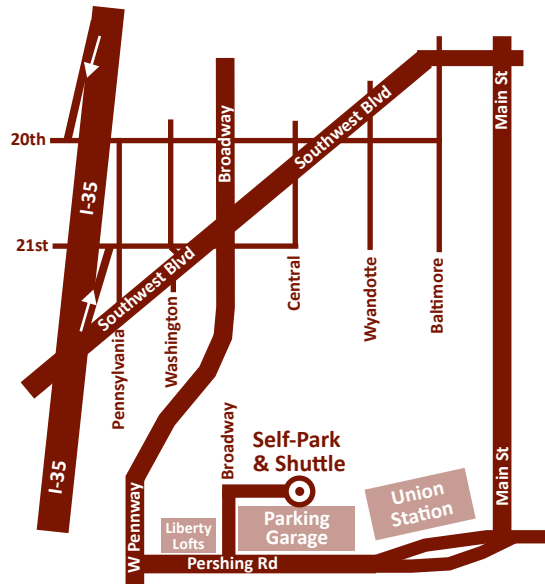


OFF-SITE PARKING DIRECTIONS & EVENT INFORMATION



Free self-parking and a courtesy shuttle will be available for Red Hot Night guests in the Union Station Parking Garage.

Multiple other events are taking place the same evening near the Convention Center, so traffic congestion will be significantly increased and nearby parking lots will *not* be available for self-park. Red Hot Night guests who self-park are strongly encouraged to do so for free in the Union Station Parking Garage where security will be on site and shuttles will run constantly to the gala at the Convention Center.

Guests should enter at Pershing and Broadway (by Liberty Lofts) under the “Union Station Parking” sign and look for Red Hot Night signs for additional directions.

MAY I CHOOSE TO PAY FOR VALET?

Our valet parking will be at capacity for this sold-out event, and there is an event at every venue in downtown Kansas City meaning traffic surrounding the Convention Center will be slow and surface parking will be scarce. Guests are encouraged to take advantage of our complimentary off-site covered parking and Children’s Mercy shuttles, or use taxis, zTrip or Uber. Should you choose to use a driving service and get dropped off, please see the map on opposite side for very specific directions to the car service drop-off lane, and share the drop-off directions with your driver.

NO TICKETS, JUST CHECK-IN

Tickets will NOT be distributed. Rather, there will be a registration table right inside the entrance where all guests must check-in. Guest may pre-register online to expedite registration. When you arrive, we will verify your contact information and ask for a credit card to have on file for any purchases you make that evening. At the end of the night, there is no need to check-out unless you prefer to remove purchases from your credit card and instead pay by cash, check, another card or request an invoice. If you need to make a guest substitution, please do your best to email events@cmh.edu and make sure the guest knows who they’re replacing or what sponsor they are with.

ATTIRE

Red Hot Night is black-tie optional. This means if you have a tux, wear it. If you don’t, do not purchase one for this occasion. 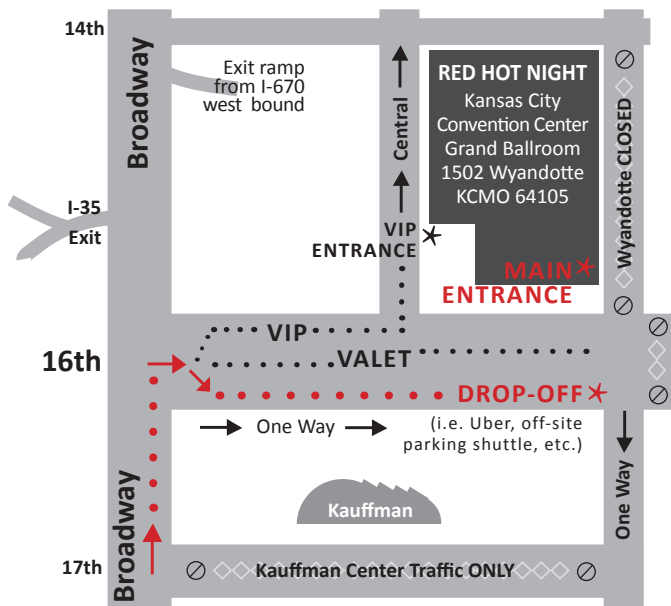
FOOD ALLERGIES & SPECIAL NEEDS

DO I NEED CASH?

No. There is an open bar all evening long and coat check is complimentary, as is off-site parking and the shuttle service. You will need a credit card to register at check-in for any auction purchases or donations you make during the evening (but you can decide to pay for it using another method at check-out if you wish - it’s like having a card on file when you check in to a hotel).

DROP-OFF DIRECTIONS & EVENT INFORMATION



If you are a guest of a \$15,000 and below sponsor/table and are arriving in car service, Uber, etc., please provide these directions to your driver.

**If you're at a VIP sponsor table (\$25,000 and above sponsors) and being dropped off, please go to the VIP Entrance on Central and follow the VIP Entrance directions instead of these.*

- On Feb. 16th, the **ONLY WAY TO REACH THE ENTRANCE** is by taking **Broadway to 16th Street**.
- Go **NORTH on Broadway**
- Turn **RIGHT on 16th Street**.
- Stay in the **FAR RIGHT lane for drop off**.
- Follow directions from parking attendants to the drop-off point at the corner of 16th and Wyandotte Streets at the ballroom main entrance.

- **CLOSURES:** 16th St. is CLOSED between Wyandotte and Baltimore, and Wyandotte is CLOSED between 14th and 16th Sts.
- **ONE-WAYS:** 16th St. will become one-way east-bound and Wyandotte will be one-way south-bound between 16th and 17th Streets during arrival time on the night of the event. All **one-way traffic patterns will REVERSE DIRECTION at the end of the night** for departures.
