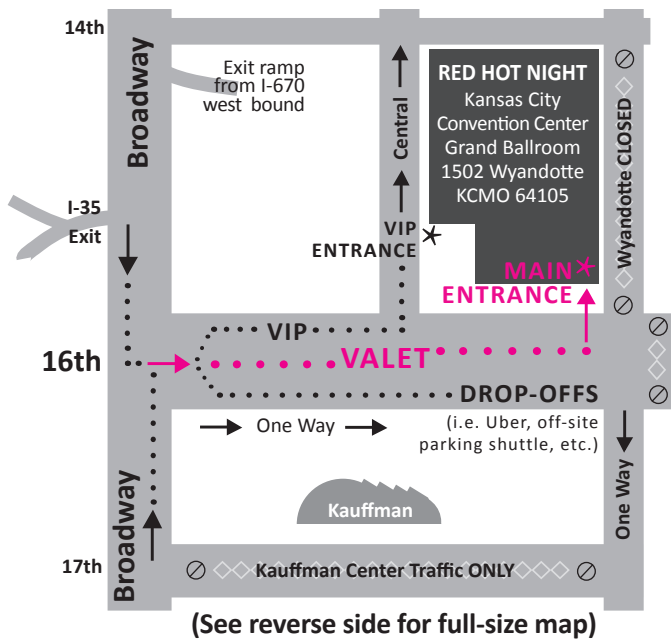


RED HOT NIGHT

VALET DIRECTIONS & EVENT INFORMATION



You must have a **pink valet pass** to use valet.
(If your table's sponsorship comes with valet passes, they were mailed to your table host who will distribute them to their guests.)

- On Feb. 16th, the **ONLY WAY TO REACH THE VALET LINE** is by taking **Broadway to 16th St.**
- From Broadway, arrive on 16th Street going east-bound and use the **CENTER lane for valet.**
- Follow directions from valet attendants to the valet drop-off point at the corner of 16th and Wyandotte Streets at the ballroom main entrance.
- NOTE: 16th Street will become **ONE-WAY** east-bound during arrival time on the night of the event; 16th St. is **CLOSED** between Wyandotte and Baltimore, and; Wyandotte is **CLOSED** between 14th and 16th Streets and will be one-way south-bound between 16th and 17th Street.

WHAT IF I DON'T HAVE A PINK VALET PASS?

Without a pink pass, unfortunately you can't valet this year (we're sorry). Guests are encouraged to take advantage of our complimentary off-site parking, taxis, zTrip or Uber. Our valet parking will be at capacity for this sold-out event, and there is an event at every venue in downtown Kansas City meaning traffic surrounding the Convention Center will be slow and surface parking will be scarce. Complimentary off-site parking will be available at Union Station and Children's Mercy shuttle buses will be taking guests directly to the Grand Ballroom entrance (visit www.redhotnight.org to download the off-site parking map and directions).

NO TICKETS, JUST CHECK-IN

Tickets will NOT be distributed. Rather, there will be a registration table right inside the entrance where all guests must check-in. Guests may pre-register online to expedite registration. When you arrive, we will verify your contact information and ask for a credit card to have on file for any purchases you make that evening. At the end of the night, there is no need to check-out unless you prefer to remove purchases from your credit card and instead pay by cash, check, another card or request an invoice. If you need to make a guest substitution, please do your best to email events@cmh.edu and make sure the guest knows who they're replacing or what sponsor they are with.

ATTIRE

Red Hot Night is black-tie optional. This means if you have a tux, wear it. If you don't, do not purchase one for this occasion and plan to wear a suit. TAKING A TAXI, zTrip OR UBER?

If you are choosing to take a taxi, zTrip or Uber to Red Hot Night, please tell your driver to utilize the far right (south) lane on 16th Street for drop-off, then watch your text messages during the event for directions on where the Uber/zTrip/taxi pick-up location will be. Streets near the Convention Center are completely closed or converting to one-ways, so be sure to follow the directions provided and share them with your driver. RED HOT NIGHT

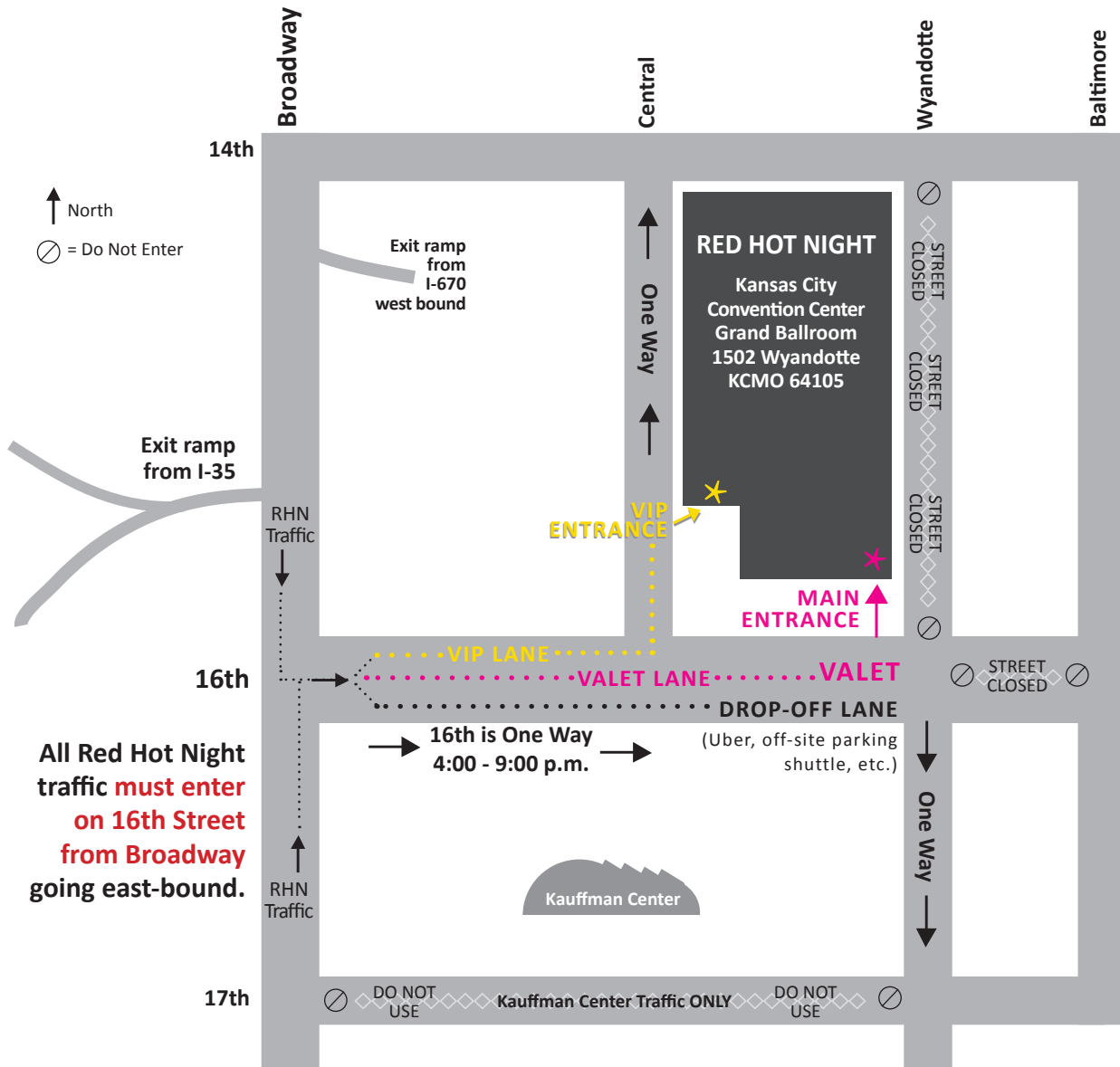

ALL RED HOT NIGHT TRAFFIC MUST ENTER ON 16TH STREET FROM BROADWAY.

This is due to street closures surrounding the Kansas City Convention Center.
