


RED HOT NIGHT

VIP ENTRANCE DIRECTIONS & EVENT INFORMATION



You must have a **yellow VIP hang tag** to access Central Street and the VIP entrance.
(If your table's sponsorship comes with VIP passes, they were mailed to your table host who will distribute them to their guests.)

- On Feb. 16th, the only way to reach the event is by taking **Broadway to 16th Street**.
- From Broadway, arrive on 16th Street going east-bound and use the **far LEFT lane** for VIPs.
- Turn **LEFT on Central Street**. Please note, that you will NOT be able to enter Central from 14th Street.
- Follow directions from parking attendants to the VIP drop-off on Central Street just north of 16th.
- NOTE: Please have your **yellow VIP hang tag** displayed in clear view *before* reaching 16th St.

WHAT IF I DON'T HAVE A YELLOW VIP HANG TAG?

You must REMEMBER and clearly DISPLAY your yellow VIP hang tag, but if you find yourself in a pinch, please tell the parking attendant you're a \$25,000 (or higher) sponsor and indicate which sponsor you're with so he/she can verify from the list. If you choose to take Uber or other car service, please disregard the general attendee Drop-Off lane instructions and have your Uber driver display your yellow hang tag and follow the VIP Entrance directions.

DO I HAVE TO USE THE PRIVATE ENTRANCE? WHAT IF I'M WITH PEOPLE WHO ARE NOT \$25,000+ SPONSORS?

We encourage you to use the VIP Entrance because the exclusive entrance provides our lead sponsors with virtually no line at drop-off, a very quick check-in and coat drop-off, quick drink service and a warm welcome by a concierge who will ensure your group has a smooth, fun experience at Red Hot Night all evening long. If you're with others who aren't \$25,000+ sponsors, have them drop off at the VIP Entrance and they can walk down the corridor to the MAIN public entrance. If you end up using the public entrance yourself, please let the check-in desk know you're a \$25,000 or higher sponsor and they'll see that you're taken care of.

NO TICKETS, JUST CHECK-IN

Tickets will NOT be distributed. Rather, there will be a registration table right inside the entrance where all guests must check-in. Guests may pre-register online to expedite registration. When you arrive, we will verify your contact information and ask for a credit card to have on file for any purchases you make that evening. At the end of the night, there is no need to check-out unless you prefer to remove purchases from your credit card and instead pay by cash, check, another card or request an invoice. If you need to make a guest substitution, please do your best to email events@cmh.edu and make sure the guest knows who they're replacing or what sponsor they are with.

ATTIRE

Red Hot Night is black-tie optional. This means if you have a tux, wear it. If you don't, do not purchase one for this occasion and plan to wear a suit. RED HOT NIGHT


